Board Responsibilities: The Richland County First Steps (RCFS) Partnership Board takes its responsibilities seriously, and we want to share with you an idea of what it means to be a part of this organization. To be nominated and (s)elected, and to give time and talents to this, the RCFS Partnership Board, a Board member will be expected to join us in working in all of the following areas. Your particular talents may be best utilized in one area more than another.

- 1. *Policy Maker* Makes decisions on issues, policies, goals and objectives based on careful consideration of the facts and all relevant data.
- 2. *Committee Responsibility* Each member is assigned to a working committee and will be expected to attend meetings, participate and accept responsibilities on that committee.
- 3. *Advocacy* Each member agrees to serve as an ambassador for RCFS and assist in the advocacy efforts to promote the vision, mission, and goals of RCFS.
- 4. *Attendance* Board members are expected to attend each scheduled and called board and committee meeting. In accordance with the RCFS by-laws, a member may be asked to leave if they miss more than half of the scheduled and called meetings.
